About Shruti

Shruti Kothari has always been a character. From her early childhood, her greatest passion has been to perform and entertain others. As an adult, she channelled this passion into a dynamic career as a successful stage actress, performing at the Stratford Festival, Young People's Theatre, Thousand Islands Playhouse, and more.

On March 7, 2020, Shruti's life changed in an instant when she suffered a severe brain haemorrhage and stroke that paralysed the left side of her body. She was only 30 years old.

In the hours, days, weeks, and months that followed, the incredible teams at the Toronto Western Hospital and Toronto Rehab Institute saved Shruti's life and set her on the path to recovery. In the years since, she has continued to make immense progress with the support of these teams.

Shruti has chosen to frame the anniversary of her stroke as a day of gratitude and celebration - her 'Stroke of Genius' day. She is also determined to support the extraordinary doctors, scientists, and other medical professionals conducting ground-breaking research to understand the human brain and developing ways to help those who have suffered from brain injuries.

This year, together with her sisters, Akshara Chandhok and Shraddha Walker, Shruti has organised a fundraising trivia night to support the Krembil Brain Institute and Toronto Rehab Institute through the UHN Foundation.
